# **Defining Abstract Art**

- Paintings or sculptures that does not depict a person, place or thing in the natural world -even in an extremely distorted or exaggerated way
- The subject of the work is based on what you see: color, shapes, brushstrokes, size, scale and, in some cases, the process

# Principles of Abstract Art

- Art can be appreciated for its line and use of color alone
- Even paintings that are very realistic can still be boring
- Drew off inspiration of Celtic and arabesque art

# Origins

- Movement started in 1911 in Russia by Vassily Kandinsky
  - Associated abstract art with emotion and music
- Spread with popularity of cubism, and surrealism

## Use of Color

### **Emotions**

Red - lively and confident

Green – Peace and Inner Strength

Blue – Deep and supernatural

Yellow – Warm, Exciting, Disturbing

White – Silence, purity, potential

### Sounds

Red - Trumpet

Green - Violin

Blue - Flute

Yellow – Triumphant trumpets

White – Harmonious Pause

Can be used to display emotion of painter or

portray emotions

- Direction






# Stretching the rules of Art
