Poster should include:

- Short summary (2-3 sentences) of the types of work you could do to help the environment
- Where you would be able to work
- Average salary/hourly wage
- Job Outlook
- Required education and skills
- Summary of how the work would connect to the goals of the SDGs
- Profile of an individual who works in that career
 - Including the projects they've worked on, where they've been working

On the back of the poster write down the average salary that someone makes in the chosen career, where you would want to live/work, and the cost of an average home for the area (use the zillow average home value calculator - https://www.zillow.com/home-values/). Try to determine whether or not you could afford to live there on your salary (general rule is you can afford a house three times as much as your average yearly income).
