The Black Death

- Named the Plague
- In 5 years it killed 1/3 of Europe •
  - About 25 million people (worldwide 100 million)
- Originated in Mongolia or China
  - Spread to Europe along \_\_\_\_\_
  - Carried by Fleas that lived on the backs of rats
