 - Make sure you use different symbols for the world cities and the different U.S.
 cities

Task 3 - Add the Costliest Natural Disasters

- Do some internet research and add the 5 deadliest natural disasters (in terms of loss of life) in the world as map notes to your map
- Do some internet research and add the 5 most costly natural disaster in U.S. History (in terms of money spent on cleanup and recovery) and add as map notes to your map

Task 4 - Discussion Questions

- Once you are done with your maps, work with your partner to come up with answers to the following discussion questions
 - What connection is there between deadliest/costliest natural disasters and where humans are living?
 - Why is it so important that humans take into account the natural environment when they are choosing where to live/grow?
 - What dangers appear evident as human populations continue to grow?
 - Are there any areas of the world/U.S. that are of particular concern and why?
